Campers will enjoy their time with us this summer. Many activities are planned on and off the water. Enjoying healthy outdoor fun and getting exposure to a variety of different boats, meeting new friends, and learning about water safety will be a memorable experience. Every Friday there will be a hot dog BBQ that is included in your camp fee.

WHAT TO BRING :

- ✓ Ensure the completed AND signed registration waiver is brought on the first day (you can print off from the website if required)
- ✓ Comfortable loose fitting clothing – Bring an extra set as Campers will get wet!
- ✓ Healthy lunch and snacks
- ✓ Large water bottle labelled clearly with identification
- ✓ Running shoes required for on-land activities
- ✓ Water shoes are optional for in the water activities
- ✓ Hat and sunscreen
- ✓ Towel(s)
- ✓ A bag or backpack to keep all personal items together in one location.
- ✓ Weather appropriate clothing in the event of rain
- ✓ PFD's (life jackets) are provided, but Campers are welcome to bring their own.

There is no garbage service at the PMPC site. We ask that the Campers help us maintain a tidy site and take home everything they bring, including garbage and recyclables.

LOCATION: 14411 Harris Road, Pitt Meadows

- The PMPC Club is located on the southwest side of Harris Road where the road crosses the Alouette River at Menzies Crossing Bridge aka Silver Bridge. There is ample free parking on the east side of Harris Road just before the bridge.

FIRST DAY OF CAMP – ARRIVAL TIME:

- On the first day of each camp, arrive at 8:45 am to allow sufficient time for check in and processing of any outstanding paperwork.

PMPC CLUB PROPERTY:

- We are fortunate to be able to share the PMPC club with you. It is a jewel in our community and we want to ensure all users treat the property with the respect that it deserves.

AFTER CAMP CARE:

- After care from 2 pm-4 pm (sharp) is provided to Campers **on a pre-registration** basis at least one week prior to camp start date to allow for sufficient staffing. The rate is \$25 for the 2 hour session per child. If you require after care, and have not registered, contact the club at info@pmpc.ca to see if there is still an opportunity to register.
